BSPS SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIPS

1st and 2nd Open prize winners from Classes 8, 15 and 16 and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners from Class 7 will qualify for the 2017 BSPS Championship Show provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 23 and 28 and ridden by a BSPS member.

THE BSPS "CLASSIC SECURITY (UK) LTD" BSPS Rule 516

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge in the following classes: OPEN LEADING REIN AND FIRST RIDDEN, CRADLE STAKES, NURSERY STAKES, and LR OF HT . The highest placed pony that has not qualified for the 2017 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the "BSPS Challenge", the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony. If after qualifying a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the "BSPS Challenge".

THE BSPS BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES BEST RIDER OF THE YEAR

The Best Rider in each of the following classes will be awarded a Best Rider Card and qualify for the final at the Summer Championships - Open Lead Rein, Open First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes. Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, classes to riders who have not attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

THE HERITAGE WOW FACTOR

Open to ponies that have been placed First in Heritage affiliated Open/Restricted classes during the Winter and Summer seasons to qualify for the Winner of Winners at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

STARTER STAKES

Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 1 - 1st Starter Stakes (NO lead rein ponies)

Judged on control and jump position over poles in walk and trot. Followed by walk and trot show.

CLASS 2 - Starter Stakes (LEADING REIN PONIES INCLUDED)

X poles, followed by short show.

CLASS 3 - Starter Stakes (NO lead rein ponies)

50cm height, followed by short show.

CLASS 4 - Starter Stakes (NO lead rein ponies)

60cm height, followed by short show.

Outside assistance may be given for above classes

CLASS 5 - Leading Rein Working Hunter Pony

Ponies 4 years old and over, not exc. 122cm., riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 6 - Unaffiliated Tiny Tots

Ponies 4 years old and over, not exc. 122cm., riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

All first prize winners of each class will be eligible for the Supreme Championship

The highest placed 4a member from each class will receive a rosette

CLASS 7 - B.S.P.S. Open Cradle Stakes

Ponies 4 years old and over, not exc. 122cm., riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 8 - B.S.P.S. Open Nursery Stakes

Ponies 4 years old and over, not exc. 133cm., riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Mini Working Hunter Pony Championship

Open to 1st and 2nd placed ponies from Open Cradle Stakes and Open Nursery Stakes

CLASS 9 -Heritage M&M Open Cradle Stakes

Ponies 4 years old and over, not exc. 122cm, riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Ponies 4 years old and over, not exc. 133cm, riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Heritage Open Mini M&M Working Hunter Pony Championship

CLASS 14 - Unaffiliated Tiny Tots First Ridden Pony

Ponies 4 years old or over, not exc. 122cm, riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 15 – Combined Open and Novice Lead Rein Show Pony or Show Hunter Pony

Ponies 4 years old or over, not exc.122cm. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders on novice ponies to wear a **WHITE** armband.

(Rosettes to Open and Novice winners of Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony section)

All first prize winners will be eligible for the Supreme Championship at the end of the Show

The highest placed 4a member from each class will receive a rosette

CLASS 16 – Combined Open and Novice First Ridden Show Pony or Show Hunter Pony

Ponies 4 years old or over, not exc. 122cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders on novice ponies to wear a **WHITE** armband.

(Rosettes to Open and Novice winners of Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony section)

CLASS 18 – Combined Open and Novice Heritage M&M First Ridden Pony

Ponies 4 years old or over, not exc. 128cm, riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders on novice ponies to wear a **WHITE** armband.
